

How does a telephone seminar work?

A telephone seminar is an interactive distance education tool that will allow you to listen and participate in a live presentation from the comfort of your own office or home; all you need is your touch-tone phone!

Materials (provided electronically only) and instructions for joining the phone CLE will be e-mailed 24-48 hours before the seminar.

CLE Credit Information

KBA telephone seminars are provided from noon to 1:00 pm and have either applied for or have already received approval for 1.0 hours of Kansas Continuing Education Credit.

Check individual programs/brochures for current credit status.

To obtain CLE credit, each attendee must complete a registration form and use an individualized pin number to gain access to the call the day of the seminar. These pin numbers will be identified on your registration confirmation notice. The Kansas CLE Commission also requires each attendee to answer a series of questions posed by the presenter throughout the seminar using a touch-tone phone.

Limitations

Please note: The Kansas CLE Commission allows only 5 hours of Alternative Delivery CLE (which includes Telephone CLEs) to count toward your annual requirements.
